The Mayor announced that the ordinance has been finally passed. The ordinance is as follows.

#38-02

Any non-resident person, or persons, firm or firms, or corporations, offering goods or wares of any description to the retail trade for sale or exchange, within the corporate limits of the city of Tatum, Texas, shall pay into the Treasury of the City of Tatum, Texas, a Tax of not less than \$25.00 per day or fraction thereof.
