# ORDINANCE NO. 59-01

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING AND FIXING THE MAXIMUM SCHEDULE OF RATES TO BE CHARGED BY UNITED GAS CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, IN THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS, FOR NATURAL GAS AND NATURAL GAS SERVICE FURNISHED BY IT TO CONSUMERS, CONTAINING DEFINITIONS, FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF GAS RATES PRESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE, MAKING MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That United Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to place in effect the following schedule of rates within the corporate limits of the City of Tatum, Texas (hereinafter called "City"), for the supply of natural gas and natural gas service:

## GENERAL RATES

Rate Schedule No. 49-1, a copy of which is attached, marked Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof.

The above described schedule of general service rates, as adjusted in the manner therein provided, are the highest rates that may be charged by United Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, for consumers within the City. Other lower rates may be fixed and determined from time to time by United Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, for gas and gas service furnished to consumers within the City.

SECTION 2. That the term "consumer" as used herein shall be defined as set out in said Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. That natural gas supplied by United Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, is for the individual use of the consumer at one point of delivery and shall not be resold or shared with others.

SECTION 4. That the maximum rates and charges prescribed in this ordinance for consumers shall apply as maximum rates and charges to all gas used by such consumers to whom such rates are applicable after their regular meter reading dates commencing on the day next following the effective date of this ordinance, viz, the date of passage hereof.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

SECTION 6. That nothing contained in this ordinance shall be construed as in any manner, now or hereafter, limiting or modifying the right and power of the City, under the law, to regulate the rates charged by United Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, within the City.

Read in full and passed and adopted at a regular meeting on the 2nd day of SEPTEMBER, 1959, and approved by the Mayor.

#### GENERAL NATURAL GAS SERVICE

## RATE SCHEDULE 49-1

## APPLICATION OF SCHEDULE

This schedule is applicable to natural gas service to any customer for all uses.

Natural gas supplied hereunder is for the individual use of the customer at one point of delivery and shall not be resold or shared with others.

## NET MONTHLY RATE

\$1.50 per month, which includes the use of 500 cubic feet 11¢ per 100 cubic feet for the next 2,500 cubic feet 6¢ per 100 cubic feet for all additional gas used.

Whenever revisions of the city gate rate paid by United Gas Corporation are filed with the Federal Power Commission, or other appropriate jurisdictional body, the above consumer rates shall be adjusted, either plus or minus, to reflect the amount of the change in the average unit cost of gas supplied under this rate schedule above or below the average unit cost of such gas at the city gate rate in effect on the 1st day of January, 1959, such adjusted consumer rates to apply to all gas used after the regular meter reading dates falling on or after the effective date of such city gate rate change.

If, as a result of any decrease in the city gate rate, the Company receives refunds of any increased costs that have been passed on to consumers under the foregoing gas cost adjustment clause, the consumer rate adjusted as provided above which would otherwise be in effect will be reduced to effect such refund during the twelve—calendar—month period thereafter by an amount per one hundred cubic feet determined by dividing the amount of such refund by the total volume of gas sold under the above consumer rate during the twelve calendar months immediately preceding the month in which such refund is received by the Company.

Minimum Monthly Bill: \$1.50 Net

#### PAYMENT

The above net monthly rate increased by 10% is the gross monthly rate. All bills shall be rendered on the gross basis. The difference between the gross and net rates, representing a discount, shall be allowed for payment of bills within 10 days from date of bill.
