## AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TATUM TELEPHONE COMPANY AN INCREASE IN RATES:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

1. That Tatum Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, be, and they are hereby granted an increase in rates to be charged for their services under their franchise in the City of Tatum; such increase to become effective upon said Telephone Company putting into use a new automatic dial system. Effective on the change-over date to such system, said Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, shall be entitled to charge the following monthly rates:

Single Party Business	\$ 9.00
Two-Party Business.	8.00
Multi-Party Business	7.00
Each Business Extension	2.00
Single Party Residential	6.00
Two-Party Residential	5.00
Three or Four-Party Residential	4.00
Five to Ten-Party Residential	3.75
Each Residential Extension	1.50

- 2. RE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the franchise granted to M. G. Young, Sr. by the City of Tatum on December 9, 1952, is hereby amended insofar as the same pertains to the rates provided for therein, and that each of the remaining portions of said franchise shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this rate increase shall not alter, repeal or revoke any ordinance levying a gross receipts tax or franchise tax upon said Telephone Company, or its predecessors.
- 4. The fact that the telephone system in the City of Tatum is in serious need of immediate revisions and improvements creates an emergency, and the requirement that an ordinance be read at three separate meetings is hereby waived.
