

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR INCREASED HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN THE CITY OF TATUM AND AGREEING TO PARTICIPATE IN A SPECIAL RURAL HOUSING DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Tatum recognizes the need for overall improvement in the quality and quantity of the housing stock of the community; and

WHEREAS, there is particular concern for the housing opportunities of the low- and moderate-income family; and

WHEREAS, the East Texas region has been selected for the development of a Rural Housing Demonstration Project, to be coordinated by the East Texas Council of Governments (ETCOG); and

WHEREAS, the City of Tatum has been specially invited to participate in the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Tatum, that:

1. The City shall officially indicate its desire and intention to participate with three other communities in the development and conduct of the demonstration project;
2. The project at the local level shall be coordinated by ETCOG and in accordance with the project proposal as submitted by ETCOG and approved by the Texas Department of Community Affairs.
3. A local housing advisory committee, with no less than 6 nor more than 12 members, shall be named within thirty days of the adoption of this resolution. Such committee shall include in its membership, as ex-officio, a member of the City Council; and it shall otherwise be representative of those interests common to the housing industry, including builders, lenders, developers and private citizens.

4. Periodic reports and recommendations will be received from the advisory committee and considered by the City Council as appropriate during the twelve months of the project, with a final report to be submitted by the advisory committee on or about August 1, 1976.
