

## RESOLUTION

OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK  
GRANT PROGRAM PREAPPLICATION TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF  
HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT: AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ACT AS THE CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED  
REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S  
PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tatum desires  
to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing  
and a suitable living environment and expanding economic oppor-  
tunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income;  
and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent an imminent  
threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best public interest that  
the City of Tatum avail itself of the Community Develop-  
ment Block Grant Program for Non-Metropolitan Discretionary  
Grants under Title I of the Housing and Community Development  
Act of 1974; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tatum desires  
the Mayor to act as the City's Chief Executive Officer and  
Authorized Representative;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

1. That a Community Development Block Grant Program  
Preapplication for Discretionary Grant for Non-  
Metropolitan Cities, on behalf of the City, is  
hereby authorized to be filed with the Secretary  
of the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban  
Development.

2. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this preapplication and the City's participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program.
