MINUTE ORDER

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In RUSK AND PANOLA COUNTIES a FARM TO MARKET ROAD is hereby designated extending from State Highway 43 in Tatum, South to 2.1 miles North of Farm to Market Road 1251, a distance of approximately 7.6 miles, subject to the condition that Rusk and Panola Counties and the City of Tatum will furnish all required right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State and acquisition procedures will be in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.

At such time as Rusk and Panola Counties and the City of Tatum shall accept the provision of this Order and agree to the furnishing of the required right of way, the Engineer-Director is directed to proceed with the engineering development, Relocation Assistance at an estimated cost of \$1,000 and construction of the project in the most feasible and economical manner at an estimated cost of \$850,000, and to assume the road for State maintenance upon completion of the construction.

This Order is subject to acceptance by Rusk and Panola Counties and the City of Tatum and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically cancelled.
