A RESOLUTION BY THE TATUM CITY COUNCIL TO THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS PROTESTING THE PRESENT BUS SERVICE SCHEDULE TO THE TATUM AREA RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES BY CONTINENTAL TRAILWAYS BUS LINES

The City of Tatum and the Tatum City Council are displeased with the present schedule of bus service to the Tatum Area residents and businesses by the Continental Trailways Bus Lines; the present schedule being one bus arrives in Tatum daily from the north going south with no bus returning from the south.

Also, the City of Tatum and the Tatum City Council are very displeased with the Railroad Commission of Texas for allowing such inadequate service to this area and for their failure to give adequate notice of the change in schedule of service which became effective September 3, 1980.

NOW, TEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TATUM, THAT:

A more appropriate schedule be restored to our City and Area.
