

RESOLUTION

OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF TATUM, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT: AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tatum desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best public interest that the City of Tatum avail itself of the Community Development Block Grant Program for Small Cities under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tatum desires the Mayor to act as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

1. That a Community Development Block Grant application for discretionary funds under the Small Cities Program is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. That the City Commission directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program.
