KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

WHEREAS, certain areas of the City of Tatum have been and are subject to periodic flooding which causes serious damage to properties located within these areas; and

WHEREAS, under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended, residents of the City of Tatum can purchase federally subsidized flood insurance if the City of Tatum qualifies for and participates in the National Flood Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council of the City of Tatum to qualify for such participation in said Flood Insurance Program and to require the recognition and evaluation of Flood Hazard within such areas located within the boundaries of the City of Tatum, Texas, for all proposed new developments within such areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tatum has authority to adopt and enforce Flood Plain Management rules and regulations to reduce future flood losses pursuant to sub-chapter 1, section 16.315 of the Texas Water Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Tatum agrees that it will enact as necessary and maintain in force land use control measures with effective enforcement provision consistent with rules and regulations set forth in section 60.3 of the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations; and will vest in the Mayor or his official designate, the responsibility, authority and means to do all things necessary to provide for such land use and control measures including any and all necessary reports incident to such program.

NOW, THEREFORE, on this the 15 day of February, 1982 in a meeting of the City Council of the City of Tatum, Texas, duly convened and acting in its capacity as a governing body of said city, the following members being present:
