RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Tatum that the Tatum Volunteer Fire Department be trained and well qualified in the arts and sciences of firefighting and,

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Tatum desires that all members of the Tatum Volunteer Fire Department be trained and qualified in such arts and sciences,:

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tatum, Texas that, in order to encourage such above-mentioned training and certification, and in order to encourage all members of the Tatum Volunteer Fire Department to become certified firefighters under the rules, regulations and statutes of the State of Texas, if any such member of the Tatum Volunteer Fire Department, being certified as stated above, received his household water supply from the City of Tatum, then such member attending one meeting each month of the Tatum Volunteer Fire Department will receive free water from the City of Tatum for such month: it being hereby designated that such free water shall be defined as follows, to-wit; one water meter at the residence of such member of the Tatum Volunteer Fire Department, said residence being designated as such members homestead, and such free water to be the first two thousand gallons of water and sewer service, any additional water or service to be billed to said member at current rates therefor.
