RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO RE-ROUTE A PORTION OF SPUR 43 WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF TATUM, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the railroad underpass on S.H. 43N is undersized in width and has a posted height restriction of 13'10".

WHEREAS, the current route of Spur 43 is located entirely west of the said underpass and does not allow a bypass of the said underpass.

WHEREAS, the economy of the small City of Tatum, Texas needs state permitted oversized loads to travel S.H. 43.

WHEREAS, construction companies and haulers of all types need a more direct legal route to their destinations.

WHEREAS, a portion of the proposed re-route was formerly F.M. 1794 and was constructed to state farm to market specification.

NOW; THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Tatum, Texas; that a formal request is made to the Texas Department of Transportation to re-route a portion of Spur 43 within the city limits of Tatum, Texas.
