## RESOLUTION 2002- 02

A RESOLUTION FOR AGREEMENT TO REGULATE SUBDIVISION PLATS AND APPROVE PERMITS IN THE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS PURSUANT TO SECTION 1 OF SECTION 242.001 V.T.C.A. LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE

WHEREAS, effective September 1, 2001 the Local Government Code requires a municipality and a county to enter into a written agreement prior to April 1, 2002 that identifies the governmental entity authorized to regulate subdivision plats and approve related permits in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of such municipality;

WHEREAS, the City of Tatum, Texas and Panola County, Texas desire to enter into a written agreement as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS AND THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF PANOLA COUNTY, TEXAS:

The City of Tatum, Texas and Panola County, Texas hereby agree to the following matters:

- 1. Panola County, Texas shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to regulate subdivision plats and approve related permits in the extraterritorial jurisdiction in Panola County of the City of Tatum, Texas as it now exists or hereafter amended pursuant to Section 1 of section 242.001 V.T.C.A. Local Government Code and may regulate subdivisions under Subchapter A of Chapter 212 and other statutes applicable to municipalities.
- 2. The present extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Tatum, Texas is one-half (½) mile. Section 42.021(1) V.T.C.A. Local Government Code.
- 3. The City of Tatum, Texas agrees to notify Panola County of any expansion or reductions in the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- 4. Panola County's subdivision rules and regulations for road construction shall be the minimum standard; however, the City's subdivision rules and regulations for road construction may be more stringent.
- 5. This Agreement is effective only for the extraterritorial jurisdiction in Panola County, Texas.
