## RESOLUTION 2006-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF RURAL COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FUNDS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tatum desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of Tatum to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TATUM, TEXAS:

- That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for Texas Community Development Funds is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City of Tatum with the Office of Rural Community Affairs.
- 2. That the City's application be placed in competition for funding under the Community Development Fund.
- 3. That the application be for \$250,000.00 of grant funds to carry out water construction activities, project engineering and program administration.
- 4. That City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.
- 5. That it further be stated that the City of Tatum is committing \$17,500.00 toward the water construction activities.
